FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR URBAN REFUGEES & VULNERABLE JORDANIANS

With limited access to cash and banking, many families affected by the high cost of living have been unable to meet basic needs. This has affected the ability of families to meet their basic needs.

The aim of this financial assistance is to help families meet their basic needs. Recipients will receive a cash grant of \$120-180 per month (\$170-254 USD) each month. This will help them to buy food, pay rent, and cover other essential expenses.

IRC has provided cash assistance to 6,000 families across Jordan. This includes emergency cash transfers, ATM cards, and mobile phones. A cash transfer of \$120-180 per month is equivalent to approximately \$170-254 USD per month. This will help families to buy food, pay rent, and cover other essential expenses.

UPCOMING PROJECT

IRC Jordan will provide cash assistance to 10,000 families in Mafraq Governorate. This will help them to buy food, pay rent, and cover other essential expenses.
